Templates and Order Sets

eClinicalWorks includes age-based and gender-based templates for well-child visits and encounters for common childhood illnesses such as croup, jaundice, reflux, swimmer's ear, and teething. Any standard SOAP note can be saved as a template. And providers have access to a wide range of Order Sets, pre-configured, evidence-based treatment plans covering medications, labs, imaging, procedures, referral guidance, and patient education.

Immunization Tracking

The immunization module, accessible from the Progress Notes, contains all relevant data to review a patient's immunization history, screen for contraindications and precautions, and administer a vaccine in real time. The user-friendly design enables you to efficiently document the date of administration, vaccine manufacturer, vaccine lot number, the person administering the vaccine, and document a vaccine information statement (VIS) as given. All documentation flows directly to the interface with your state's immunization registry.

The module also provides real time vaccine forecasting with recommended schedules and age-based alerts based on CDC and ACIP recommendations, available through Immunization Calculation Engine's web service.

Smart Forms and Specialty Forms

Smart Forms, such as the PHQ-2 and PHQ-9, enable the provider to get the score and interpretation of the patient's depression screening automatically. This data also flows directly into the Progress Notes. The Progress Note now includes Specialty Forms for managing common conditions, including weight, asthma, and ADHD.

Vitals and Growth Charts

The vitals module has extensive safeguards to help flag implausible values if data entry errors occur. It can also track minimum and maximum ranges of up to 20 of a patient's vitals. This allows for a glance at high or low numbers, such as BMI or BP. Birth Vitals also allows your practice to document the patient's birth weight, length, head circumference, APGAR scores, and hearing exam outcomes.

Providers can now find Growth Charts in Patient Portal for patients up to age 20. This enables providers to easily track patient development through percentiles plotted on a curve. eCW also supports Growth Charts for specialty conditions, including pre-term and Downs Syndrome.

CHADIS

The Child Health & Development Interactive System (CHADIS) assists providers in addressing parents' concerns about their children's behavior and development. Parents can collaborate in care by entering data online. CHADIS collects and returns results to the EHR as structured data in the History of Present Illness.

Proxy Portal

eClinicalWorks offers a Proxy Portal that gives adolescents the ability, in accordance with state-by-state age regulations, to determine the level of access that parents and guardians may have to the child's health records, ranging from no access to full access.

healow Kids

The healow Kids smartphone app helps parents track their children's health, from birth through age 13. They can monitor the growth and feeding of their baby, track appointments and immunizations, and get help with tasks like toothbrushing and training. And healow Kids helps practices reduce no-shows, keep schedules full, and more effectively communicate with parents.
