

## AOM Management has a Large, Often Ignored, Quality Gap



Ear infections are the leading cause of antibiotic prescriptions<sup>1,2</sup>...

...the leading cause of surgeries in children3...





...and the second leading cause of sick-child office visits4,5

Correct diagnosis of ear infections varies between 25-88%. As a result, AOM is over-diagnosed and over-treated up to 58% of the time. 6,7,8,9


